Nancy Berns is the author of *Closure: The Rush to End Grief and What It Costs Us*, and professor of sociology at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa, where she teaches classes on grief, death, emotions, violence, and justice. She is also author of *Framing the Victim: Domestic Violence, Media and Social Problems*. Her current research explores how people carry grief and joy together after loss.

Nancy attracts a national and international audience through her popular TEDx talk (*Beyond Closure*) and interviews such as those with *The Boston Globe*, *The Guardian*, *The L.A. Times*, *Huffington Post Live*, *U.S. News & World Report*, *CBS News*, *Real Simple*, and *Prevention*. She also provides consultation and seminars for community groups, schools, churches, hospice/social workers, counselors, and corporations.
